On Monday, May 28, the office will be closed for the Memorial Day Holiday.



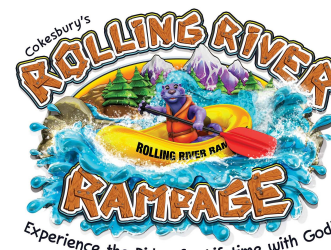
